Gift Aid is really important. For every £1 your supporters donate (provided they pay tax at the time of donation), we are able to claim an extra 25p from the taxman. This extra money can make a huge difference, so please do encourage your eligible supporters to say that they are happy for us to claim Gift Aid on their donations when they fill in your sponsorship form.

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STAY LEGAL AND KEEP IT SAFE

Fundraising is all about having fun and raising money but it's also subject to laws and legislation. Here is the need-to-know info broken down for you.

Collections

Collections are a great way to raise money, especially in a busy area. However if you're planning a collection that takes place in a publicly owned place then this is governed by strict legal requirements and must be licensed by your local authority, Manchester City Council.

Before you approach the City Council for a licence, please advise us of your plans and await approval as the charity can only apply for a set number of licences per year. Licences are not required on privately owned land – just ensure you have the permission of the owner or business.

Raffles and lotteries

Raffles, lotteries and prize draws are all governed by legislation – so before holding one and spending money on getting tickets printed, please contact us. Also, be aware that lottery laws cover any events which are purely down to luck or chance, such as duck or balloon races even.

If you want to hold a simple raffle at your event, that is fine as long as the tickets are sold and drawn on the same day.

Insurance

When you organise a fundraising event, you're responsible for making sure it poses no risk to others. That's why we'd recommend you take out public liability cover for events such as a sponsored walk or sports event. Unfortunately, our own policy won't cover you but we can advise you about the kind of cover you need. Just get in touch with us.

Food hygiene

Please take great care when handling food and work to basic rules for safe preparation, storage, display and cooking. No one likes a poorly tummy, especially as a reward for raising money for charity.

Data protection

Make sure any electronic or paper records you keep about people involved in a fundraising event complies with the Data Protection Act. As a rule of thumb, don't keep information about people any longer than you have to, and don't share information or data about someone without their permission.

Set a target

Fundraisers often tell us that they find it helpful if they set themselves a fundraising target. Not only does it help them to stay motivated right up until the big day, but it also helps boost the total that they raise, so it's definitely worth considering. After all, the more money you raise, the more people in Manchester we can help.

Virgin Money Giving

Virgin Money Giving is the easy way to raise money. It makes it simple to set up your own fundraising web page and collect donations from friends and family online. That means no more paper sponsorship forms. It's super simple to create your own page. Just go to

www.virginmoneygiving.com/charitities/welovemcrcharity to set up your page and share the link to let your supporters see how you're fundraising is going. Once you've created your page, please let us know so that we can help support you. And, of course, if you need any help setting it up, please just contact us at welovemcrcharity@manchester.gov.uk.

Gift Aid

For every £1 the people who are sponsoring you donate (provided they are paying tax at the time of the donation) HMRC will give us an extra 25p at absolutely no cost to them. So, in order for us to magically turn every pound you raise into £1.25, please make sure all of your supporters use Gift Aid on their donations.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

About us

Every penny raised for the charity stays here in Manchester. We Love MCR Charity is focussed on supporting young people and promoting stronger communities, helping to build a better future for Manchester.

Over a third of children and young people in Manchester are growing up in poverty and a large number of these young people do not have the personal family and social networks that can help them move into aspirational careers. We Love MCR Charity supports young people to gain the knowledge, skills and confidence they need to succeed, helping to build a better future for Manchester.

For example every summer we fund selected young people and their families from across Manchester to attend a course at the One Education Outdoor Centre in Windermere. Children and parents experience a range of outdoor activities which help build self awareness and develop self confidence as well as developing new skills and aspirations. For many this experience stays with them forever.

Our new Sir Howard Bernstein Endowment Fund aims to support young Mancunians with education, enterprise and employment, to ensure they play their fullest possible part in the economic life of the city, and in particular to support their routes into employment or business. We are currently developing projects to support young people across the city.

We Love MCR Charity supports communities to come together to build stronger relationships in and across those communities. The charity provides grants to local community groups. We have funded a wide range of projects in recent years. Some examples include a Winter Night shelter for homeless men, a dementia support group in South Manchester, a project for young people with learning difficulties and a volunteering programme for the long term unemployed in the city centre. Our grant programme will be focusing on bringing communities together to build stronger relationships in and across those communities over the coming year.

The current Lord Mayor is Councillor Eddy Newman, who became Lord Mayor in May and has a year in the role. Our Deputy Lord Mayor, Councillor June Hitchen will become Lord Mayor mid May 2018.

The Lord Mayor's charity is separate to the We Love MCR Emergency Fund which was the charity set up to help the people affected by the attack at Manchester Arena. The Emergency Fund has raised £20m so far and the money will go to be eaved families and people who were injured or traumatised by the attack.
